I realized, again, that I need to prioritize how I spend my day doing parish ministry so that I can spend more time with people and leading our ministry together and less time feeling like "The Administrator". I realized that I'd better shorten that personal "to do" list and accomplish some of the personal goals I've put off for too long.

How was your summer? Did you take time for reflection, renewal and recommitment? I hope the process revitalized your life and makes you a better parent, grandparent, spouse and employee. I hope you deepened your spiritual life and can better hear Jesus' voice and see Jesus' presence in your life. May God bless all of you!!!
